

Weston & Crewe Green Neighbourhood Plan

UPDATE June 2026

The Draft Plan has now been the subject of a vigorous appraisal by an Independent Examiner, and his final report is currently with Cheshire East, the current owners of the Plan.

The Examiner has suggested minimal amendments and has been extremely complementary as to the way in which the Plan has been prepared.

The next stage is a **REFERENDUM** which will take place sometime during the summer. You will be updated further once the date is known. Cheshire East will be responsible for overseeing and monitoring this.

The referendum will be confined to residents living within the Plan area, (see plan overleaf) and the results will dictate as to whether the Neighbourhood Plan becomes a part of the statutory planning process alongside the Cheshire East Local Plan until 2030.

In short, the aim of the plan, supported by its policies, is to protect and enhance the character of the seven settlements which make up the plan area, as well as its countryside and history. The Plan will assist our community in resisting unplanned development and unwanted urban sprawl.
